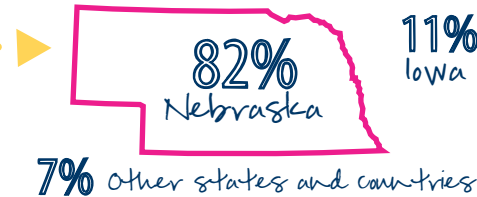

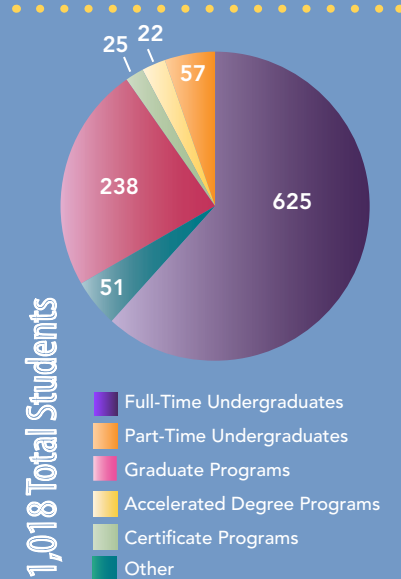

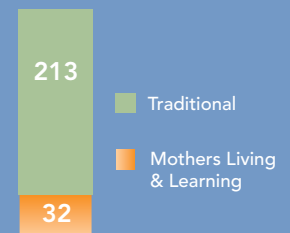

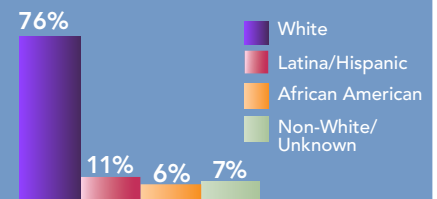


Residential Students
