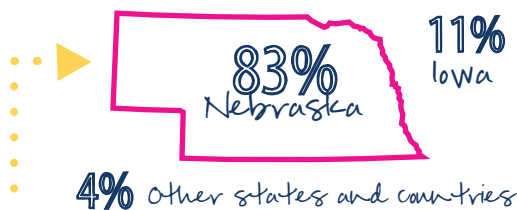

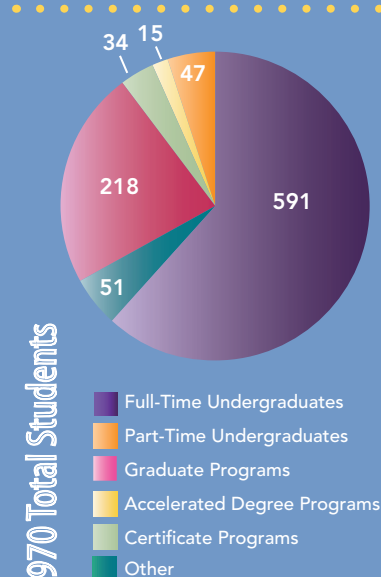

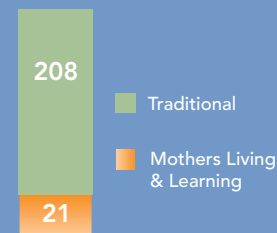

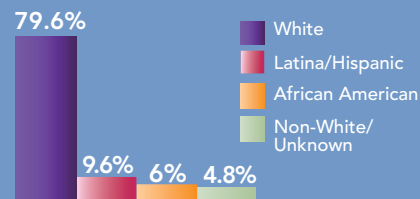


Residential Students
