CSM Bachelor degrees require a minimum of 128 credits. Transfer students must complete a minimum of 15 credits in the major and 30 credits overall at CSM. Developmental courses do not count toward degree requirements. Students must receive a B or better in MCC law courses for transfer. A maximum of 64 credits may be transferred from a two-year college.
